



## R 2017

A deeply cherry-red wine, almost black at the core with violet reflections. On the nose, it immediately reveals a strong barrique tone reminiscent of coffee, dark chocolate, and walnuts. The pronounced vegetal notes reflect aromas of beans, green bell pepper, and black pepper. On the palate, the wine reveals more fruit than initially expected, with a slightly sweet character. The tannin and acidity structure is distinct but softened by fruity aromas. The alcohol content appears restrained. The finish is long and expressive, showcasing the wine's powerful character.
