A wine that presents itself in a medium cherry red with delicate violet reflections. The barrique aging is immediately noticeable on the nose with spicy notes of pepper, cedarwood, and toasted black bread. These are complemented by tart fruit aromas of sloe, cassis leaf, juniper berry, and plum. On the palate, the wine is juicy yet structured, with fine acidity and a pronounced but polished tannin structure. The alcohol appears moderate for such an expressive red wine. The medium-bodied finish is distinctly shaped by the tart fruit notes and the fine spice from the wood.
